The Mosaic covenant, unlike the preceding four, is not found concisely contained within a few chapters of one book, rather it spans the life of Moses, over four books from **Exodus** through to **Deuteronomy**, and comprises three parts, the Commandments (**Ex.20**), the Statutes (**Ex.21-24**) and the Ordinances (**Ex.25-31**) that were respectively to govern the moral, social and religious lives of the Israelites

- Could be understood to refer to either the intensity or the duration of God’s punishment for Israel's sin – but here means duration!
- Now a “time” in prophecy refers to a specific period . EG **Rev.12:1,6** refers to a period of 1,260 days, but **Rev.12:14**, referring to the same event, refers to a time(1), times(2) and half a time(0.5) so $1+2+0.5$ times = 1260 days

- From which we can conclude that 7 “times” could mean 2,520 days
- Also in Bible prophecy, we sometimes find that a prophetic ‘day’ stands for a year of real time eg **Ez.4:6, Gen.29:27, Num.14:33, Dan.9:24** etc
- **So, 7 times = 2520 days = 2520 years!**
